Coldest Night of the Year Volunteer

Coldest Night of the Year is an annual fundraising walk across Canada which has raised over \$75 million dollars for local charities who support people experiencing homelessness. The walk is in over 200 locations from coast to coast, with FIRST UNITED being the proud host of the Vancouver Downtown Eastside Walk for 9 years!

This year, our goal is to raise \$120,000 for our life-saving work providing essential services, community connection and healing to folks who need it. We need lots of volunteers to help us put on this event!

The Walk this year is on February 22, 2025, starting and ending at 312 Main St. Volunteer shifts will begin at 3pm and end at approximately 7pm.
