

Volunteer - Food Truck Driver

Position Overview:

The FIRST UNITED Food Truck is up and rolling!

Because our building at 320 E Hastings is in the process of being redeveloped, we have shifted our well-known community meal service to a Food Truck format, Monday through Friday at noon. This service is incredibly important to the DTES community, as it feeds approximately 200 people each day.

We need skilled and experienced drivers to help us set up the truck at its location each day. You will also get the opportunity to help with the food service once the truck is in position.

Key Responsibilities

- Safely and efficiently drive food truck to the First United kitchen and then to its
 designated service spot, and then back to its lot after service
- Support staff when necessary, by assisting with clean up and food service

Skills and Knowledge

- Skilled, confident and comfortable driving a large commercial vehicle (at least 20 feet)
- Experience parking and navigating in a large commercial vehicle (at least 20 feet)
- Must be punctual for every shift the community relies on us for food
- Must have a positive, can-do attitude

Requirements

- Must be at least 25 years old
- Must possess a valid BC Class 5 driver's license with no prohibitions or suspensions
- Must provide ICBC driver's abstract for review
- Must have a reliable transportation method to the DTES
- Must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 (two weeks after second dose)
- Must sign confidentiality agreement
- Must pass a vulnerable sector criminal record check





Commitment

- 1 shift a week, landing on the same day of the week
- Approximate shift time will be 11:30 AM 1:00 PM
