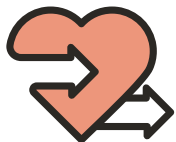
Building Connections Campaign

Facing the compounding homelessness, overdose, and COVID-19 crises, our neighbours in the Downtown Eastside are in urgent need of space for healing, connection, and care. **FIRST UNITED** has served the DTES community for over 135 years, but to adequately respond to these complex challenges and the direct and growing needs of our community, we need your help.



The Need for First Forward

Demand for our services has outgrown our space at 320 East Hastings, and the space itself is falling into disrepair. Regardless of circumstance, all people deserve the dignity and care that a safe, purpose-built space can provide.

Revitalizing the corner of Hastings and Gore is a community-led neighbourhood rejuvenation that centres reconciliation and healing.

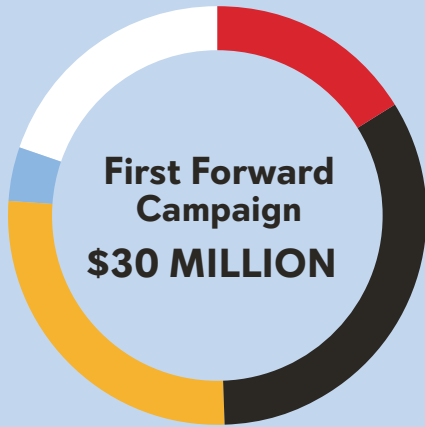
A Sanctuary Within Our City

To address the critical housing, health, and social justice needs of our community, we are partnering with Lu'ma Native Housing Society to redevelop our site into a multi-storey, purpose-built space that will offer four floors of community amenities, programs and services, as well over 100 units of below-market rental housing for Indigenous Peoples. Based on extensive consultation with our DTES neighbours, this project is informed by the community for the community, and we are extremely excited to build a space that provides the healing, connection, and care that our community needs.

Redeveloping our current site will mean we can move forward together. We cannot do this important work without you.



The Financials

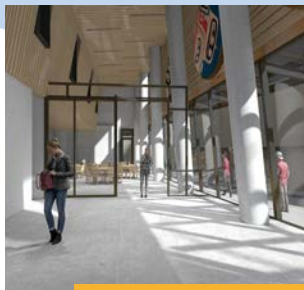


- Funds to Raise: \$4,846,529**

The proposed project includes:

Two drop-in spaces, a large dining room and commercial kitchen, a legal advocacy clinic, multipurpose spaces, public showers, a day sleeping room, an interfaith sacred space, outdoor decks, computer lab, and administrative offices
